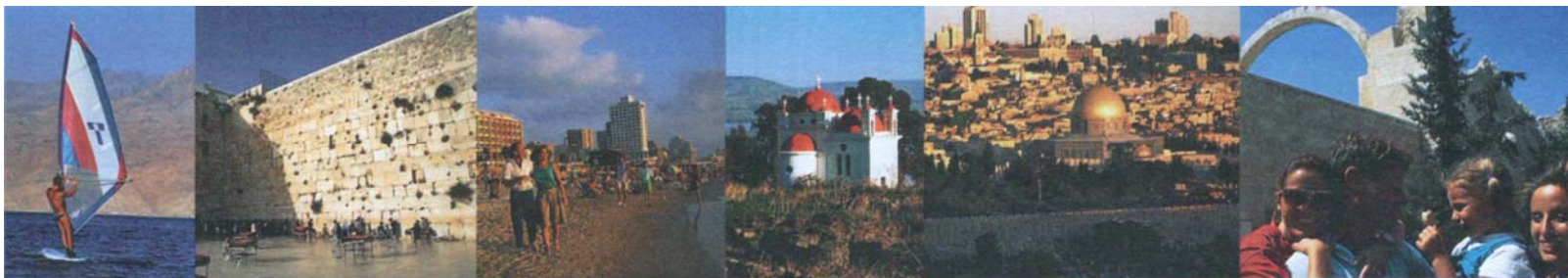

# Holyland Highlights

## CHRISTIAN FRIENDS OF ISRAELI COMMUNITIES

Depart Jerusalem, traveling south to Gush Etzion. Visit the Sound and Light Show in Kfar Etzion and learn about the special history of this area. Path of the Patriarchs, including ancient ritual paths and strategic lookout toward Jerusalem. Lone Oak Tree. Judaica Center. Visit a Gush Etzion community and meet residents. Continue north to Genesis Land and experience the hospitality of Abraham. End the day in Shiloh, the site of the Tabernacle for 369 years. Visit a Benjamin community and meet with residents. Meet with Sondra Oster Baras, Director of the Israel office of Christian Friends of Israeli Communities. Overnight in Eshel Hashomron Hotel in Ariel.

## MT. OF OLIVES/GETHSEMANE/ WESTERN WALL/YAD VASHEM/ BETHLEHEM

We start our tour of Jerusalem, the holy city to Christians, Jews and Moslems by driving up to the peak of the Mt. of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of Pater Noster and the Chapel of Ascension, then proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane. Passing the Kidron Valley, we travel to David's City and see how King David's General Joab captured the capital of Israel (ICH.11). Entering Jerusalem's ancient walls, we pass the colorful bazaars to visit the Western (Wailing) Wall. We will see some of the colossal stones King Herod laid at the foundation of the Temple. After a visit to Yad Vashem (Museum to the Memorial of the Holocaust), we shall

see the Shepherds' Fields.

## DUNG GATE /BETHESDA/ GARDEN TOMB/UPPER ROOM/ DEAD SEA SCROLLS/ JERUSALEM MODEL

In the morning, enter the city once again at the Dung Gate in order to go up to the Temple Mount. We shall visit St. Anne's Church and view the Pool of Bethesda (JN.5) and walk to where Jesus was condemned, scourged and took up the cross to start His walk to the Calvary (JN.19). Passing through the Damascus Gate and on northward is the Garden Tomb, where we shall have a tour and time for a service, if desired. In the afternoon we shall visit the Upper Room, where Jesus and His Disciples partook of the Last Supper (Mark 14). Visit the Museum of the Dead Sea Scrolls (The Shrine of the Book) and finally, given the time, visit the Model of Jerusalem as it was at the time of Jesus (50th scale).

## MASADA/DEAD SEA

We leave Jerusalem and turn eastward through the Judean Desert passing the Bedouin nomad tents on our way down to the lowest place on earth. At Masada, we will ascend by cable car and tour the ancient ruins. Here, during the Great Revolt that ended in the year 73AD, was the last stand of the Jews against the Romans. We shall stop for a short while at the Dead Sea, where you will enjoy a spa package. There will be an opportunity to bathe in the Dead Sea, so please bring suitable attire (bathing suit, towel and something for your

feet). On our return to Jerusalem, we will stop for a moment to talk about the Essenes and look up at the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were hidden.

## CAPERNAUM/MT. OF THE BEATITUDES/ CANA/SEPHORIS

Begin the day with a boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. Continue to Capernaum, Jesus' own city (Mark 1). Visit Mt. Beatitudes where Jesus gave his "Sermon on the Mount" (Matt. 5) and remember the two fish and five loaves (Mark 6) with which He fed thousands of people. Drive to Cana, the site of Jesus' first miracle (John 2.1-11) and continue to Sephoris, a major city in ancient times, and the site of the region's most beautiful mosaic floors.

## MEGIDDO/CAESAREA/TEL AVIV

Depart Tiberias and drive to visit the ancient city of Megiddo and from there look out over the Valley of Armageddon (Rev. 16). Depart for Caesarea, an excavated city which was built by Herod the Great 2000 years ago. It served as the administrative capital of Judea for over 600 years. Here Paul made his famous appeal before Festus, Felix and Agrippa (Acts 24-28). Drive through the Valley of Sharon.
